# **New Study Provides Answers To Parents**

Between August 2003 and March 2007, an independent research organization conducted a comprehensive study of parents and teens from Aspen Education Group residential therapeutic schools and programs. The purpose of the study was to measure the effectiveness of private residential programs for teens with emotional and behavioral issues and the impact upon the family.

# The results are groundbreaking.

The study concentrated on providing answers for the two key questions that parents considering a private residential program would ask. They are:

- Will my child improve while attending an Aspen residential school or program?
- Will the progress my child has made while attending an Aspen program continue upon returning home?

Both of these questions were positively answered in this study. You will discover the answers and more in this study overview.

## **Participant Background**

- 1027 youths and 1027 parents participated in the study
- Youth ages range from 13-18 years
- 94% of the youths had received some form of prior treatment
- 82% had more than one presenting issue (behavior, substance, mood, learning, anxiety)

### Key Facts

- Conducted by an independent research company
- Approved and audited by the Western Institutional Review Board
- Parent and teen responses were measured at distinct times including:
  - Admission to the program
  - 12 months post-discharge



## ASPEN'S PROGRAMS HELP TEENS FEEL BETTER ABOUT THEMSELVES

### What Parents and Their Teens Told Researchers:


#### **Upon Admission to the Program**

The majority of teens entering the program were experiencing emotional problems that minimized the individual's own control of their feelings. Teens were often experiencing high levels of:

Anxiety 
 Depression 
 Attention Problems

#### **One Year After Discharge**

Teens and parents both reported that the emotional issues the teen experienced were normal. In other words, they were behaving just like any other typical teenager.



Why This May Be Important To You: Aspen's programs helped teens to develop stronger emotional well-being. They provided teens with the confidence that can help resist peer pressure and other outside influences.

## TEENS BEHAVE BETTER AS A RESULT OF ASPEN'S PROGRAMS

### What Parents and Their Teens Told Researchers:

#### **Upon Admission to the Program**

Teens were exhibiting common behaviors that included:

Aggressiveness
 Withdrawal
 Rule breaking

#### **One Year After Discharge**

Student's behavior diminished to 'normal' levels reflecting that of a typical teenager.



Why This May Be Important To You: Most teens admitted to an Aspen program were demonstrating behaviors that were directly impacting both themselves and others. One year later, teens were **far more cooperative**, with their negative behaviors diminished to 'normal' levels.

# ASPEN PROGRAMS HELP HEAL THE WHOLE FAMILY

### What Parents and Their Teens Told Researchers:

#### **Upon Admission to the Program**

Teens and their families were showing signs of serious trouble:

- Poor family relationshipsIneffective family communications
- Noncompliance with family rules

### **One Year After Discharge**

- Positive changes occurred for the whole family:
- Improved family relationships
  Better communication
  Better compliance with rules



Why This May Be Important To You: There was significant improvement in family relationships and family communication as a result of Aspen's therapeutic schools and programs. Families are generally living better lives today because of their decision to enroll in an Aspen program.
